



AN EXAMPLE FROM SCRIPTURE:

PROCLAMATION - Acts 2:14-41

PURITY - Acts 2:42-47

POWER - Acts 3

PERSECUTION - Acts 4:1-22

IN 12 STEPS FORM:

PERSECUTION

Step 1: We admitted we were powerless over **death**—that our lives had become unmanageable.

PROCLAMATION

Step 2: Came to believe that **Jesus is greater than ourselves** and could restore us to sanity.

Step 3: **Made a decision to turn our will and our lives over to the care of Jesus.**

PURITY

Step 4: Made a searching and fearless moral inventory of ourselves.

Step 5: **Admitted to God, to ourselves, and to another human being the exact nature of our wrongs.**

Step 6: Were entirely ready to have God remove all these defects of character.

Step 7: **Humbly asked Him to remove our shortcomings.**

Step 8: Made a list of all persons we had harmed, and became willing to make amends to them all.

Step 9: Made direct amends to such people wherever possible, except when to do so would injure them or others.

Step 10: Continued to take personal inventory and **when we were wrong promptly admitted it.**

POWER

Step 11: Sought through prayer and meditation to improve our conscious contact with God praying only for knowledge of His will for us and the power to carry that out.

Step 12: Having had a spiritual awakening as the result of these Steps, we tried to **carry this message to all people**, and to practice these principles in all our affairs.
